The **Resident Teacher** is welcomed into the school community for an entire school year, serving in a mentor teacher's classroom during the school day while in their teacher preparation coursework. Serving as a **Resident Teacher** is the most effective way to experience and retain effective teaching practice.



Benefits to being a Resident Teacher:

- **Resident Teachers** are paid a stipend for their service (\$35,000)
- **Residents** experience an entire school year, from set up to break down
- Residents earn additional income from substitute teaching at their school each week
- **Residents** are considered part of the teaching staff
- **Residents** are guaranteed employment in the district of residency upon successful completion of Residency requirements
